Why Develop an Oracle PDP for Auditors?

Complex Applications

Oracle’s Financial Suite of applications is very complex. Oracle embedded best practices into the design of these applications; however, many of these best practices are profile options or configuration parameters that must be defined by the end user. There are hundreds of profile options and configuration parameters that must be set properly to ensure that the Oracle Financial applications are configured using Oracle and Industry best practices. A single profile option, if set incorrectly, can significantly increase the risk that Financial Statements are stated incorrectly. Similarly, a company may not be compliant with the laws and regulations that impact its industry.



Auditors Are Not Oracle ERP Professionals

Typically auditors are very good at auditing, but many auditors don't have any Oracle ERP experience. This increases the risk that auditors may not recognize a major risk or they may not be able to provide a proper risk assessment.

Climb Higher

We designed this Oracle PDP for Auditors to help them acquire some basic Oracle skills. Moreover, auditors with these skills are able to *"climb higher"* and differentiate themselves from auditors who lack these skills.

Earn Oracle Champion Certification

A number of GLPs at the Proficiency Level lead to certification as an OPN Champion in one or more Oracle Financial applications. Many of these GLPs contain all free Oracle online self-paced courses. This is a very cost-effective way for you become a Certified Oracle Champion and differentiate yourself from other auditors, however the knowledge that you will gain by completing these free Oracle online self-paced courses is worth far more than becoming a Certified Oracle Champion. You can simply take the assessment exam multiple times until you pass it; however, you won't learn anything and you will not have "hands on" experience.
